



# HOW TO ACCESS ZOOM

## 1) VIA THE UNIVERSITY'S **ZOOM WEB PORTAL**




## 2) VIA THE **ZOOM DESKTOP APP**




# HOW TO GET STARTED ON YOUR PERSONAL COMPUTER

## ZOOM WEB PORTAL

- 1) Go to UA's Zoom web portal: <https://arizona.zoom.us/>
- 2) "Sign In" with your NetID and password to access your personal Zoom account




3) After logging in, you'll start at your personal profile page




## ZOOM DESKTOP APP

1) To download the Zoom app to your computer, first sign out of your Zoom web portal account



2) Then click on "Download Client" at the bottom of the web portal login page




3) Download “Zoom Client for Meetings”

## Zoom Client for Meetings


The web browser client will download automatically when you start or join your first Zoom meeting, and is also available for manual download here.




4) Once downloaded to your machine, a new Zoom login window will appear. Click “Sign In”:




5) Then choose “Sign In with SSO”




6) You will be asked for your company domain




7) Type "arizona" into the text box, then click "Continue"





8) Next, click "Open Zoom Meetings"




9) You are now logged into your personal account on the Zoom app



10) Remember to “Sign Out” when you’re finished using Zoom. To do this, click on the box in the upper right corner (it will have your own initials...mine are “LA”) directly next to the search bar. Then “Sign Out”



11) There should now be a “Zoom” icon linked directly to your desktop



12) If you can't locate the icon, you can search your computer for the Zoom app and access from there
